## Testing Tools

- ANDI
  - I went through all menus on ANDI on every page and made adjustments based on its findings. I adjusted the heading levels of the sections to make it clearer what was a section header (h2) and what was a side topic (h3).
- Nu HTML Checker
  - I used this tool to check all pages on my website. Items called out included the social media links I had on the final page (Serving). I fixed this by changing from the CSS code to adding a button icon for LinkedIn and assigning a link to it. I still have the iframe error for the YouTube video on the Prepping page, but ignored it per instructions.
- WAVE
  - Used this tool to check all pages, fixing all errors. I still have a few Alerts, but I'm not worried about them. One is about two links next to each other pointing to the same location, but that is due to me offering a simple "Next" button that will guide the user through the website in the correct order.
- Mac Screen Reader
  - I used the Mac Screen Reader to tab through all pages of my entire website, ensuring the correct information was read aloud in the right order. As I was tabbing through each page I would randomly use ctrl+option+space to open links and ensure proper navigation.
