The accessibility of the website was tested using the following tools:

- 1) **Browser used for testing (e.g., *Chrome*):** Version 103.0.5060.66 (Official Build) (64-bit)
- 2) **Assistive technology used for testing:**

NVDA

I used NVDA to go through all focusable elements first. Then checked the images (simple, complex, and decorative), and made sure it reads the table content, links, and forms in a comprehensive manner. Finally, I randomly chose some of the paragraphs and found some typos thanks to NVDA! Also, all the information was read in the correct order.

- 3) **Automated testing tools used:**

ANDI

ANDI showed an alert to manually test the color contrast for the header since I used a background image. The contrast was checked using the **Color Contrast Analyzer**.

WAVE

WAVE signals alert for the documents and a video attached. The video has synchronized subtitles as well as a transcript to ensure accessibility.

NU HTML CHECKER

The checker shows that the frame border attribute on the Iframe element is obsolete and recommends using CSS instead. The embed was generated by YouTube and can be easily removed. No other errors were found.
